Section 373A.003, Local Government Code, 5 is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to 6 read as follows: 7 8 (a) This chapter applies to: 9 (1) a municipality with a population of more than 750,000 that is located in a uniform state service region with fewer 10 11 than 800,000 [550,000] occupied housing units as determined by the 12 most recent United States decennial census; and 13 (2) a municipality that contains more than 75 percent 14 of the population of a county with a population of 1.5 million or 15 more. 16 (a-1) If this chapter applies to a municipality as provided by Subsection (a), the application of this chapter to the 17 municipality is not affected if the municipality's population or 18 the number of occupied housing units changes and the municipality 19 no longer meets the population requirement of Subsection (a). 20 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
