1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to a building used as a prescribed pediatric extended care  
1-22 center.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 248A.152, Health and Safety Code, is  
1-25 amended by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (d) to  
1-26 read as follows:

1-27 (c) A center's building must be suitable for use as a  
1-28 prescribed pediatric extended care center and must provide a  
1-29 minimum of 60 square feet of space for each child, exclusive of a  
1-30 space that is:

- 1-31 (1) a kitchen;
- 1-32 (2) a bathroom;
- 1-33 (3) a storage area;
- 1-34 (4) a stairway; and
- 1-35 (5) an unfinished basement or attic.

1-36 (d) The maximum patient capacity at a center may not exceed  
1-37 100 [~~60~~].

1-38 SECTION 2. Section 248A.152(c), Health and Safety Code, as  
1-39 amended by this Act, does not apply to a prescribed pediatric  
1-40 extended care center that has a maximum patient capacity of 60 or  
1-41 fewer patients and that was operating immediately before the  
1-42 effective date of this Act.

1-43 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
