4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 434, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Sections 434.212 and 434.213 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 434.212. WOMEN VETERANS REPORT. (a) Not later than
8	November 1 of each even-numbered year, the commission shall submit
9	to the governor, lieutenant governor, and legislature a report on
10	women veterans in this state. The report must:
11	(1) estimate the:
12	(A) number of women veterans in this state;
13	(B) number of women veterans that contact the
14	commission for assistance; and
15	(C) number of women veterans who receive
16	assistance from the commission, the Texas Workforce Commission, the
17	Department of State Health Services, and other state agencies;
18	(2) identify the unique problems faced by women
19	veterans; and
20	(3) recommend policy proposals, initiatives, and
21	funding levels to address the problems identified in Subdivision
22	<u>(2).</u>
23	Sec. 434.213. WOMEN VETERANS COMMUNITY OUTREACH CAMPAIGN.
24	The women veterans coordinator designated under Section 434.203, in

- 1 consultation with the Governor's Commission for Women, the United
- 2 States Department of Veterans Affairs, and any other appropriate
- 3 agency, shall conduct a community outreach campaign to:
- 4 (1) provide information relating to and increase
- 5 awareness of benefits and services available to women veterans;
- 6 (2) improve access to benefits and services for women
- 7 veterans;
- 8 <u>(3) increase participation of women veterans in</u>
- 9 programs that provide benefits and services; and
- 10 (4) provide information on the significant
- 11 contributions of women veterans in this state.
- 12 SECTION 2. Not later than November 1, 2018, the women
- 13 veterans coordinator shall establish the women veterans community
- 14 outreach campaign as required under Section 434.213, Government
- 15 Code, as added by this Act, and the Texas Veterans Commission shall
- 16 adopt any rules necessary to implement the campaign.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
