## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the claim process for unclaimed property.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 74.501, Property Code, is amended by
5	adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
6	(g) If the comptroller or the comptroller's authorized
7	agent determines that a claim is not valid, the comptroller or the
8	comptroller's authorized agent shall deny the claim. The
9	comptroller or the comptroller's authorized agent shall mail to the
10	person aggrieved by the denial decision a notice that states that:
11	(1) the claim is denied; and
12	(2) the person may:
13	(A) before the 61st day after the day on which the
14	decision was rendered appeal the denial decision under Section
15	74.506; or
16	(B) not later than the first anniversary of the
17	date the decision was rendered:
18	(i) request a hearing under Section 74.5065
19	for review of the denial decision; or
20	(ii) appeal the denial decision under
21	Section 74.5066.
22	SECTION 2. Section 74.506, Property Code, is amended by
23	adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
24	(e) A person who appeals a decision of a claim under this

- 1 section waives the right to a review hearing under Section 74.5065
- 2 and an appeal under Section 74.5066.
- 3 SECTION 3. Subchapter F, Chapter 74, Property Code, is
- 4 amended by adding Sections 74.5065 and 74.5066 to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 74.5065. REVIEW OF CLAIM DENIAL DECISION. (a) A
- 6 person aggrieved by the denial of a claim under Section 74.501 may
- 7 request a hearing to review the denial decision by submitting to the
- 8 comptroller or the comptroller's authorized agent a request in
- 9 writing not later than the first anniversary of the date the claim
- 10 was denied.
- 11 (b) If a request is submitted as provided by Subsection (a),
- 12 the comptroller or the comptroller's authorized agent shall hold a
- 13 hearing not later than the 30th day after the date the comptroller
- 14 or the comptroller's authorized agent receives the request for
- 15 <u>review.</u>
- 16 (c) At the hearing, the aggrieved person may present
- 17 relevant evidence and argument against the denial of the claim.
- 18 (d) Not later than the 30th day after the date of the
- 19 conclusion of the hearing, the comptroller or the comptroller's
- 20 authorized agent shall affirm or reverse the denial of the claim.
- 21 The comptroller or the comptroller's authorized agent shall
- 22 promptly notify the aggrieved person in writing of the decision
- 23 <u>issued under this subsection</u>. If the comptroller or the
- 24 comptroller's authorized agent fails to issue a decision within the
- 25 period prescribed by this subsection, the denial of the claim is
- 26 affirmed.
- (e) A person aggrieved by a decision under Subsection (d)

- 1 may appeal the decision before the 61st day after the date on which
- 2 the decision was issued or the date on which the decision was
- 3 affirmed by operation of law if the comptroller or the
- 4 comptroller's authorized agent fails to issue a decision within the
- 5 prescribed period. Sections 74.506(c) and (d) apply to an appeal of
- 6 the decision under this subsection.
- 7 (f) A person who requests a review hearing under this
- 8 section waives the right to an appeal under Section 74.5066.
- 9 Sec. 74.5066. APPEAL TO JUSTICE COURT. (a) Subject to
- 10 Subsection (b), a person aggrieved by the denial of a claim under
- 11 Section 74.501 may appeal the denial decision by filing suit
- 12 against the state in justice court in the county in which the
- 13 <u>claimant resides not later than the first anniversary of the date</u>
- 14 the decision was rendered. The state's immunity from suit without
- 15 consent is abolished with respect to suits brought under this
- 16 <u>section</u>.
- 17 (b) An action may be filed under this section only if the
- 18 amount in controversy is within the limits prescribed by Section
- 19 27.031, Government Code.
- 20 (c) A justice court shall try an action filed under this
- 21 <u>section de novo.</u>
- 22 <u>(d) A person who appeals a denial decision under this</u>
- 23 section waives the right to a review hearing under Section 74.5065.
- SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 25 a claim filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A claim
- 26 filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 27 in effect on the date the claim was filed, and the former law is

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- 1 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
