## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the elimination of certain charges and programs
3	associated with the universal service fund.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 56, Utilities Code, is amended by adding
6	Subchapter I to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER I. ELIMINATION OF CHARGES AND PROGRAMS NOT REQUIRED BY
8	FEDERAL LAW
9	Sec. 56.351. ELIMINATION OF CHARGES AND PROGRAMS NOT
10	REQUIRED BY FEDERAL LAW. (a) For the purposes of this section,
11	"charge" includes a surcharge and a fee.
12	(b) The commission shall by rule adopt a plan to:
13	(1) eliminate each charge or portion of a charge that:
14	(A) is established under this chapter; and
15	(B) is not required by federal law; and
16	(2) eliminate each program or service that:
17	(A) is established under this chapter or receives
18	funding under this chapter;
19	(B) is funded solely from the universal service
20	<pre>fund; and</pre>
21	(C) is not required by federal law.
22	(c) The plan must reduce the charges or portions of charges
23	over a five-year period in equal increments so that the charges or
24	portions of charges are eliminated by the end of that period. The

- 1 five-year period must begin not later than September 1, 2018.
- 2 (d) If this section conflicts with another provision of this
- 3 <u>title</u>, this section prevails.
- 4 SECTION 2. (a) The Public Utility Commission of Texas shall
- 5 adopt rules as necessary to ensure that:
- 6 (1) a charge, surcharge, or fee established under
- 7 Chapter 56, Utilities Code, and not required by federal law is not
- 8 collected for a billing cycle any part of which falls on or after
- 9 October 1, 2024; and
- 10 (2) a charge, surcharge, or fee established under
- 11 Chapter 56, Utilities Code, due for a billing cycle completed
- 12 before October 1, 2024, is collected and remitted for deposit to the
- 13 credit of the universal service fund under Chapter 56, Utilities
- 14 Code.
- 15 (b) The change in law made by this Act does not affect the
- 16 liability for a payment of a charge, surcharge, or fee established
- 17 under Chapter 56, Utilities Code, that accrues before October 1,
- 18 2024. That liability continues in effect as if this Act had not
- 19 been enacted. The former law is continued in effect for the
- 20 collection of charges, surcharges, or fees due, for remission of
- 21 the collected charges, surcharges, or fees for deposit to the
- 22 universal service fund, for enforcement of the liability for and
- 23 remission of those charges, surcharges, or fees, and for the
- 24 purposes of Subsection (a)(2) of this section.
- 25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
