1 by that subsection for a student's enrollment in not more than three 2 electronic courses during any school year, unless the student is 3 enrolled in a full-time online program that:

4 (1) was operating on January 1, 2013; or
5 (2) is operated by a school district for the benefit of
6 students eligible to attend a school in the school district under
7 Section 25.001 or by an open-enrollment charter school for the
8 benefit of students eligible for admission to the campus or program
9 under Subchapter D, Chapter 12.

10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
