- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 301, Property Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 301.134 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 301.134. CONCILIATION AGREEMENT ENFORCEMENT. The
- 8 commission may monitor a respondent's compliance with a
- 9 conciliation agreement entered into under this chapter. If the
- 10 commission has reasonable cause to believe that a respondent has
- 11 breached a conciliation agreement, the commission shall refer the
- 12 matter to the attorney general with a recommendation for the
- 13 attorney general to file in accordance with this subchapter a civil
- 14 <u>action to enforce the agreement.</u>
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
