22	SECTION 2. Section 2308.004, Occupations Code, is amended
23	by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

- 1 of a vehicle on the property of an institution of higher education,
- 2 as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code, only as provided by
- 3 <u>Section 51.202</u>, Education Code.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 the vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
