JUDICIAL MISCONDUCT INFORMATION. 14 (a) 15 commission shall routinely provide to entities that provide 16 education to judges information relating to judicial misconduct resulting in sanctions or orders of additional education issued by 17 the commission. The commission shall categorize the information by 18 level of judge and type of misconduct. 19 20 (b) The commission shall provide online access, without providing confidential information, to a nonfrivolous complaint's 21 status, including whether the complaint: 22 23 (1) is under investigation; 24 (2) is under commission consideration; or 25 (3) has been adjudicated.

informing the public that complainants are not required to maintain

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The commission shall include on its website a statement

- 1 confidentiality with regard to their complaints.
- 2 SECTION 3. Section 33.0211(b), Government Code, is amended
- 3 to read as follows:
- 4 (b) The commission, [at least quarterly] until final
- 5 disposition of the complaint, shall notify the person filing the
- 6 complaint of a change of $[\frac{1}{2}]$ status in $[\frac{1}{2}]$ the investigation of
- 7 the complaint unless the notice would jeopardize an undercover
- 8 investigation.
- 9 SECTION 4. Subchapter B, Chapter 33, Government Code, is
- 10 amended by adding Sections 33.02115 and 33.02116 to read as
- 11 follows:
- 12 Sec. 33.02115. SANCTION GUIDELINES. The commission shall
- 13 publish guidelines to provide for a sanction to be proportional to
- 14 the misconduct.
- Sec. 33.02116. TIME FRAME. The commission shall establish
- 16 guidelines outlining when the commission should take action on a
- 17 complaint. The time frame must allow the executive director to
- 18 approve an extension of a deadline due to extenuating
- 19 circumstances, including a necessity for further investigation.
- 20 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
