1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the amount of compensation and allowances of a county
1-18 auditor in certain counties.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 152.032(d), Local Government Code, is
1-21 amended to read as follows:

1-22 (d) The amount of the compensation and allowances of a
1-23 county auditor in a county subject to this subsection may be set in
1-24 an amount that exceeds the limit established by Subsection (a) if
1-25 the compensation and allowances are approved by the commissioners
1-26 court of the county. This subsection applies only to:

1-27 (1) a county with a population of more than 108,000 and
1-28 less than 110,000;

1-29 (2) a county with a population of 120,000 or more,
1-30 excluding a county subject to Subsection (b);

1-31 (3) a county with a population of more than 1,000 and
1-32 less than 23,000 that borders the Gulf of Mexico; ~~and~~

1-33 (4) a county with a population of more than 11,000 and
1-34 less than 11,650; and

1-35 (5) a county that:

1-36 (A) borders a county with a population of more
1-37 than one million; and

1-38 (B) has a population of more than 36,000 and less
1-39 than 40,000.

1-40 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-41 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-42 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-43 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-44 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
