S.B. No. 1788

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the execution of a warrant issued for certain
3 individuals who violate a condition of release on parole or to
4 mandatory supervision.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 508, Government Code, is
7 amended by adding Section 508.2525 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 508.2525. WARRANT FOR CERTAIN VIOLATIONS OF
9 SUPER-INTENSIVE SUPERVISION PROGRAM. A law enforcement agency
10 shall execute, as soon as practicable, a warrant that is directed to
11 the agency and issued for the return of a releasee in the
12 super-intensive supervision program based on a violation of a
13 condition of parole or mandatory supervision related to the
14 electronic monitoring of the releasee.

15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
16 to an arrest warrant that is issued on or after the effective date
17 of this Act. An arrest warrant that was issued before the effective
18 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the
19 warrant was issued, and the former law is continued in effect for
20 that purpose.

21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
