## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to petty cash funds for county welfare departments in

- 3 certain populous counties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 130.905(a), Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The commissioners court of a county with a population of
- 8 1.3 million or more, for the support of paupers through a county
- 9 welfare department, may authorize the disbursement of an amount set
- 10 by the commissioners court [not to exceed \$2,500] to the head of the
- 11 county welfare department for use as a petty cash fund in order that
- 12 cash is immediately available for transportation and other expenses
- 13 of the paupers. The petty cash fund must be established under a
- 14 system provided and installed by the county auditor with reports to
- 15 be made to the auditor, as the auditor may require, by the head of
- 16 the county welfare department.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
