3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 411.0141, Government Code, is amended to
5	read as follows:
6	Sec. 411.0141. MULTIUSE TRAINING AND OPERATIONS CENTER
7	FACILITY. (a) The Texas Facilities Commission shall construct a
8	multiuse training and operations center facility to be used by the
9	department, the Texas military forces, county and municipal law

- 11 agency, including agencies of the federal government:
- 12 $\underline{(1)}$ [τ] for training purposes;
- 13 (2) to house law enforcement assets and equipment; and

enforcement agencies, and any other military or law enforcement

- 14 (3) to support and initiate tactical operations and
- 15 law enforcement missions.
- 16 (b) The Texas Facilities Commission, with the assistance of
- 17 the department, shall locate and acquire real property for the
- 18 purpose of constructing the training and operations center
- 19 facility. The governing body of a county, \underline{or} [or] municipality, \underline{or}
- 20 <u>navigation district</u>, on behalf of the county, [or] municipality, or
- 21 <u>navigation district</u>, may donate real property to the department for
- 22 the [training] facility. The donation may be in fee simple or
- 23 otherwise.

(c) The department shall, with the assistance of the Texas

- 1 Facilities Commission, design the training and operations center
- 2 facility.
- 3 (d) On completion of the construction of the training and
- 4 operations center facility, the Texas Facilities Commission shall
- 5 transfer ownership of the [training] facility, including the real
- 6 property and buildings, to the department.
- 7 (e) The department shall manage the training <u>and operations</u>
- 8 center facility and may adopt rules necessary to implement this
- 9 section. The department shall make the [training] facility
- 10 available for use by the department, the Texas military forces,
- 11 county and municipal law enforcement agencies, and any other
- 12 military or law enforcement agency, including agencies of the
- 13 federal government. The department may set and collect fees for the
- 14 use of the [training] facility.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
