- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 531.1022(a), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The commission's office of inspector general shall
- 9 employ and commission not more than five peace officers at any given
- 10 time for the purpose of assisting the office in carrying out the
- 11 duties of the office relating to the investigation of fraud, waste,
- 12 and abuse in:
- 13 (1) Medicaid;
- 14 (2) the financial assistance program under Chapter 31,
- 15 Human Resources Code;
- 16 (3) the supplemental nutrition assistance program
- 17 under Chapter 33, Human Resources Code; and
- 18 (4) the federal special supplemental nutrition
- 19 program for women, infants, and children authorized by 42 U.S.C.
- 20 <u>Section 1786</u>.
- 21 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 22 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 23 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 24 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or

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- 1 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 2 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
