11	(3) include an explanation of:
12	(A) the basic career and college readiness
13	components of each endorsement under Section 28.025(c-1);
14	(B) the curriculum requirements to gain
15	automatic college admission under Section 51.803; and
16	(C) applicable course, graduation plan, and
17	endorsement requirements for financial aid authorized under Title
18	3, including curriculum requirements for:
19	(i) the TEXAS grant as provided under
20	Subchapter M, Chapter 56; and
21	(ii) the Texas Educational Opportunity
22	Grant Program as provided under Subchapter P, Chapter 56[; and
23	[(iii) the Texas B-On-time loan program as
24	provided under Subchapter Q, Chapter 56].
