## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the establishment of a human trafficking unit within
3	the Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 411.02096 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 411.02096. HUMAN TRAFFICKING UNIT. (a) In this
8	section:
9	(1) "Human trafficking" means conduct that

  10 constitutes an offense under Section 20A.02, Penal Code.
- 11 (2) "Unit" means the human trafficking unit
  12 established by this section.
- 13 (b) A human trafficking unit is created within the 14 department to investigate and combat human trafficking.
- 15 (c) The unit shall collaborate with federal and local law
  16 enforcement agencies and the office of the attorney general's human
  17 trafficking prevention task force and transnational and organized
  18 crime division, as applicable, to investigate human trafficking and
  19 arrest persons determined to have engaged in human trafficking.
- 20 (d) The department, in consultation with the office of the 21 attorney general, shall develop and provide specialized training 22 for peace officers assigned to the unit.
- (e) The unit may implement a public outreach campaign to combat human trafficking and may accept gifts, grants, or donations

- 1 or work with a nonprofit organization for purposes of implementing
- 2 the campaign.
- 3 (f) If the unit implements a campaign under Subsection (e),
- 4 the unit shall collaborate with local law enforcement agencies,
- 5 school districts, and faith-based organizations and places of
- 6 worship to educate persons younger than 18 years of age concerning
- 7 the dangers associated with human trafficking.
- 8 (g) The legislature may appropriate funds to the department
- 9 from the fugitive apprehension account for purposes of implementing
- 10 this section.
- 11 (h) The department shall develop guidelines and protocols
- 12 designed to minimize intrusion on a person who has an encounter with
- 13 a peace officer performing a duty of the unit under this section.
- 14 (i) The department may adopt rules as necessary to implement
- 15 this section.
- SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2018, the Department
- 17 of Public Safety of the State of Texas shall establish the human
- 18 trafficking unit under Section 411.02096, Government Code, as added
- 19 by this Act.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
