## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the implementation of county solid waste management 3 programs in certain counties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 364.011, Health and Safety Code, is 6 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to 7 read as follows:

8 (a) Subject to the limitation provided by Sections 361.151 9 and 361.152 (Solid Waste Disposal Act), <u>and subject to Subsection</u> 10 <u>(a-1)</u>, a commissioners court by rule may regulate solid waste 11 collection, handling, storage, and disposal in areas of the county 12 not in a municipality or the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a 13 municipality.

14 (a-1) A commissioners court by rule may regulate solid waste 15 collection, handling, storage, and disposal by establishing a 16 mandatory program under Section 364.034 in an area of the county 17 located within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality 18 <u>if:</u>

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
