4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 31, Penal Code, is amended by adding
6	Section 31.19 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 31.19. THEFT OF PETROLEUM PRODUCT. (a) In this
8	section, "petroleum product" means crude oil, natural gas, or
9	condensate.
10	(b) A person commits an offense if the person unlawfully
11	appropriates a petroleum product with intent to deprive the owner
12	of the petroleum product by:
13	(1) possessing, removing, delivering, receiving,
14	purchasing, selling, moving, concealing, or transporting the
15	petroleum product; or
16	(2) making or causing a connection to be made with, or
17	drilling or tapping or causing a hole to be drilled or tapped in, a
18	pipe, pipeline, or tank used to store or transport a petroleum
19	product.
20	(c) Appropriation of a petroleum product is unlawful if it
21	is without the owner's effective consent.
22	(d) An offense under this section is:
23	(1) a state jail felony if the total value of the
24	petroleum product appropriated is less than \$10,000;

1	(2) a felony of the third degree if the total value of
2	the petroleum product appropriated is \$10,000 or more but less than
3	<u>\$100,000;</u>
4	(3) a felony of the second degree if the total value of
5	the petroleum product appropriated is \$100,000 or more but less
6	than \$300,000; or
7	(4) a felony of the first degree if the total value of
8	the petroleum product appropriated is \$300,000 or more.
9	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
