4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 38.0141, Education Code, is amended to

7	Sec. 38.0141. REPORTING OF CERTAIN HEALTH AND SAFETY
8	INFORMATION REQUIRED. (a) Each school district shall provide to
9	the agency information as required by the commissioner, including
10	statistics and data, relating to student health and physical
11	activity and information described by Section $28.004(k)$, presented
12	in a form determined by the commissioner. The district shall
13	provide the information required by this $\underline{\text{subsection}}$ [$\underline{\text{section}}$] for
14	the district and for each campus in the district.
15	(b) Not later than one year after the agency receives the
16	information required by Subsection (a), the commissioner shall
17	complete a report on physical education provided by each school

district and publish the report on the agency's Internet website.

- 2 (3) the average physical education class size at each

- 4 (4) the number of physical education teachers in the
- 5 district who are licensed, certified, or endorsed by an accredited
- 6 teacher preparation program to teach physical education;
- 7 (5) whether each campus in the district has the
- 8 appropriate equipment and adequate facilities for students to
- 9 engage in the amount and intensity of physical activity required
- 10 under Section 28.002;
- 11 (6) whether the district allows modifications or
- 12 accommodations that allow physical education courses to meet the
- 13 needs of students with disabilities; and
- 14 (7) whether the district has a policy that allows
- 15 teachers or administrators in the district to withhold physical
- 16 <u>activity from a student as punishment.</u>
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
