A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to sending notice of proposed contracts for highway
- 3 projects by e-mail.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 223.003, Transportation
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 223.003. NOTICE OF PROPOSED CONTRACTS [BY MAIL].
- 8 SECTION 2. Sections 223.003(a), (b), and (c),
- 9 Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 10 (a) A person may apply to have the name of the person placed
- 11 on a [mailing] list to receive notice of any proposed contracts.
- 12 (b) The department shall $\underline{\text{send}}$ [$\underline{\text{mail}}$] the notice to each
- 13 person on that [mailing] list. The department may send the notice
- 14 by mail or electronically to an e-mail address designated by the
- 15 person.
- 16 (c) The department may require each applicant to pay an
- 17 annual subscription fee set by the department in an amount not to
- 18 exceed the average annual costs of <u>sending</u> [mailing] notices to the
- 19 applicant.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
