1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to sending notice of proposed contracts for highway
1-20 projects by e-mail.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 223.003, Transportation
1-23 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 223.003. NOTICE OF PROPOSED CONTRACTS [~~BY MAIL~~].

1-25 SECTION 2. Sections 223.003(a), (b), and (c),
1-26 Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-27 (a) A person may apply to have the name of the person placed
1-28 on a [~~mailing~~] list to receive notice of any proposed contracts.

1-29 (b) The department shall send [~~mail~~] the notice to each
1-30 person on that [~~mailing~~] list. The department may send the notice
1-31 by mail or electronically to an e-mail address designated by the
1-32 person.

1-33 (c) The department may require each applicant to pay an
1-34 annual subscription fee set by the department in an amount not to
1-35 exceed the average annual costs of sending [~~mailing~~] notices to the
1-36 applicant.

1-37 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-38 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-39 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-40 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-41 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
