1	AN ACT
2	relating to the requirements for and inspection of a retail
3	fireworks site.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 2154.001, Occupations Code, is amended
6	by adding Subdivisions (9-a), (16-a), and (16-b) to read as

- 8 (9-a) "Indoor retail fireworks site" means a retail
- 9 fireworks site, other than a retail stand, that sells fireworks
- 10 1.4G from a building or structure.

follows:

- 11 (16-a) "Retail fireworks site" means a location that
- 12 has a valid retail fireworks permit issued under Section 2154.202.
- 13 (16-b) "Retail stand" means a retail fireworks site
- 14 that sells fireworks 1.4G over the counter to members of the general
- 15 public who always remain outside the structure.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 2154, Occupations Code, is
- 17 amended by adding Section 2154.2025 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 2154.2025. INSPECTION OF RETAIL FIREWORKS SITE; FEES.
- 19 (a) For purposes of this section, the local fire prevention
- 20 <u>officer with jurisdiction is:</u>
- 21 (1) except as provided by Subdivision (2), the county
- 22 fire marshal, if the county in which the retail fireworks site is
- 23 located has appointed a county fire marshal; or
- 24 (2) the fire prevention officer of the emergency

- 1 services district in which the retail fireworks site is located, if
- 2 the county in which the retail fireworks site is located has not
- 3 appointed a county fire marshal or the county fire marshal in that
- 4 county requests the emergency services district to conduct the
- 5 inspection.
- 6 (b) If otherwise authorized under state law, a local fire
- 7 prevention officer may inspect a retail fireworks site.
- 8 Notwithstanding any other law, if a local fire prevention officer
- 9 <u>is authorized under state law to assess a fee for performing an</u>
- 10 inspection of a retail fireworks site, the inspection fee:
- 11 (1) may be assessed for a particular retail fireworks
- 12 site only once during a calendar year;
- 13 (2) if assessed, shall be assessed and collected only
- 14 by the local fire prevention officer with jurisdiction over the
- 15 retail fireworks site; and
- 16 (3) may not exceed the fee established by 28 T.A.C.
- 17 <u>Section 34.340 for an inspection conducted by the state fire</u>
- 18 marshal.
- 19 (c) To the extent of a conflict between this section and
- 20 other state law, this section prevails.
- 21 SECTION 3. Chapter 2154, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 22 adding Subchapter E-1 to read as follows:
- 23 <u>SUBCHAPTER E-1. INDOOR RETAIL FIREWORKS SITES</u>
- 24 Sec. 2154.221. FREE-STANDING STRUCTURE. The fireworks
- 25 sales building of an indoor retail fireworks site shall be a
- 26 free-standing durable structure with only one story of space
- 27 <u>accessible to the public. The fireworks sales building of a site</u>

- 1 shall not be a tent, boat, or mobile vehicle. The fireworks sales
- 2 area of a site shall not be part of a multi-use or multi-tenant
- 3 building.
- 4 Sec. 2154.222. SALES DISPLAY AREA. The sales display area
- 5 of an indoor retail fireworks site shall be sufficiently designed
- 6 to prevent customers from handling fireworks unless an attendant is
- 7 <u>directly assisting the customer.</u>
- 8 Sec. 2154.223. OFFICE AREA. An office area used for the
- 9 operation of an indoor retail fireworks site that is separated by a
- 10 one-hour fire-rated wall from the fireworks sales or storage area
- 11 may be exempted by commissioner rule from the distance requirements
- 12 prescribed by commissioner rule if the office area is reported to
- 13 and reviewed by the state fire marshal.
- 14 Sec. 2154.224. COMPLIANCE WITH SUBCHAPTER. Compliance with
- 15 this subchapter may be addressed in an inspection conducted under
- 16 <u>Section 2154.2025.</u>
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
