- 2 relating to Texas Military Heroes Day in public schools.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 29.9071 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 29.9071. TEXAS MILITARY HEROES DAY. (a) To educate
- 7 students about the sacrifices made by brave Texans who have served
- 8 <u>in the armed forces of the United States</u>, the governor shall
- 9 designate a day to be known as Texas Military Heroes Day in public
- 10 schools.
- 11 (b) Texas Military Heroes Day shall include appropriate
- 12 instruction, as determined by each school district. Instruction
- 13 may include:
- 14 (1) information about persons who have served in the
- 15 armed forces of the United States and are from the community or the
- 16 geographic area in which the district is located; and
- 17 (2) participation, in-person or using technology, in
- 18 age-appropriate learning projects at battlefields and gravesites
- 19 <u>associated with a person who has served in the armed forces.</u>
- (c) The agency may collaborate with other state agencies to
- 21 promote Texas Military Heroes Day.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
- 23 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
