6	amended by adding Section 51.808 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 51.808. NOTICE OF SELF-HELP RESOURCES. (a) The clerk
8	of each court in this state shall:
9	(1) post on the court's Internet website, if any, a
10	link to:
11	(A) the self-help resources Internet website
12	designated by the Office of Court Administration of the Texas
13	Judicial System, in consultation with the Texas Access to Justice
14	Commission, that includes information on:
15	(i) lawyer referral services certified
16	under Chapter 952, Occupations Code;
17	(ii) the name, location, and any Internet
18	website of any local legal aid office; and
19	(iii) any court-affiliated self-help
20	center serving the county in which the court is located; and
21	(B) the State Law Library's Internet website; and
22	(2) conspicuously display in the clerk's office in a
23	location frequently accessed by the public a sign with the
24	information described in Subdivision (1).

1	(b) The Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial
2	System shall prescribe the format for the information required
3	under Subsection (a).
4	SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
5	of this Act, the Office of Court Administration of the Texas
6	Judicial System shall prescribe the format of the information
7	required under Section 51.808, Government Code, as added by this
8	Act.

9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
