- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 28A.001(1), Water Code, is amended to 5 read as follows: 6
- "Aggregate production operation" means the site 7 (1)
- from which aggregates are being or have been removed or extracted 8
- from the earth, including the entire areas of extraction, stripped 9
- areas, haulage ramps, and the land on which the plant processing the 10
- 11 raw materials is located, exclusive of any land owned or leased by
- 12 the responsible party not being currently used in the production of
- aggregates. For the purposes of this chapter, the term "aggregate 13
- 14 production operation" does not include:
- 15 a site at which the materials that are being (A)
- removed or extracted from the earth are used or processed at the 16
- same site or at a related site under the control of the same 17
- responsible party for the production of cement or lightweight 18
- aggregates, or in a lime kiln; 19
- 20 a temporary site that is being used solely to
- provide aggregate products for use in a public works project 21
- involving the Texas Department of Transportation or a local 22
- 23 governmental entity;

24 (C) an extraction area from which all raw

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- 1 material is extracted for use as fill or for other construction uses
- 2 at the same or a contiguous site; [or]
- 3 (D) a site at which the materials that are being
- 4 removed or extracted from the earth are used or processed for use in
- 5 the construction, modification, or expansion of a solid waste
- 6 facility at the site or another location; or
- 7 <u>(E) an extraction area from which:</u>
- 8 <u>(i) marble or granite material is extracted</u>
- 9 for decorative or artistic uses; and
- 10 <u>(ii)</u> the average amount of riprap removed
- 11 per year in the preceding 10-year period is less than 1,500 tons.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
