S.B. No. 1929

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to maternal mortality and morbidity and pregnancy-related 2 3 deaths, including postpartum depression. Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 34.005, Health and Safety Code, 5 is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 34.005. DUTIES OF TASK FORCE. The task force shall: 7 8 (1) study and review: (A) cases of pregnancy-related deaths; and 9 10 (B) trends, rates, or disparities in pregnancy-related deaths and [in] severe maternal morbidity; 11 (2) determine the feasibility of the task force 12 13 studying cases of severe maternal morbidity; and 14 (3) make recommendations to help reduce the incidence 15 of pregnancy-related deaths and severe maternal morbidity in this state. 16 SECTION 2. Sections 34.007(a) and (b), Health and Safety 17 Code, are amended to read as follows: 18 19 (a) The department shall determine a statistically significant number of cases of pregnancy-related deaths for review. 20 The department shall <u>either</u> randomly select cases <u>or select all</u> 21 22 cases for the task force to review under this subsection to reflect a cross-section of pregnancy-related deaths in this state. 23 (b) The department shall statistically analyze aggregate 24

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data of pregnancy-related deaths and severe maternal morbidity in
 this state to identify any trends, rates, or disparities.

3 SECTION 3. Chapter 34, Health and Safety Code, is amended by 4 adding Section 34.0155 to read as follows:

5Sec. 34.0155. REPORTONMATERNALMORTALITYAND6PREGNANCY-RELATED DEATHS. The commission shall:

- 7 (1) evaluate options for reducing maternal mortality,
 8 focusing on the most prevalent causes of maternal mortality as
 9 identified in the task force's biennial report required under
 10 Section 34.015, and for treating postpartum depression in
- 11 economically disadvantaged women;

12 (2) submit a written report that summarizes the 13 commission's efforts to accomplish the tasks described by 14 Subdivision (1) to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the 15 speaker of the house of representatives, the Legislative Budget 16 Board, and the appropriate standing committees of the legislature 17 not later than December 1 of each even-numbered year; and

18 (3) to the extent authorized by state and federal law, 19 apply for federal money to fund the screening and treatment of 20 postpartum depression under Section 10005 of the 21st Century Cures 21 Act (42 U.S.C. Section 201 et seq.) and consider the 22 recommendations contained in the task force's biennial report in 23 using any federal grant money received.

24 SECTION 4. Section 34.018, Health and Safety Code, is 25 amended to read as follows:

26 Sec. 34.018. SUNSET PROVISION. The task force is subject to 27 Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued

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1 in existence as provided by that chapter, the task force is
2 abolished and this chapter expires <u>December 31, 2023</u> [September 1,
3 2019].

4 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
