A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to eligibility requirements for registration as an 1-19 1-20 interior designer. 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 1053.155, Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 1053.155. APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION TO EXAMINATION. 1-25 An applicant for a certificate of registration must apply to (a) the board, on a form prescribed by the board, for admission to the 1-26 1-27 registration examination.

1-28 (b) An application for admission to the registration examination must be accompanied by evidence satisfactory to the 1-29 1-30 board that the applicant:

(1) has <u>satisfied</u> the <u>educational</u> and <u>experience</u> <u>eligibility requirements for taking the examination of the National</u> <u>Council for Interior Design Qualification or a comparable</u> 1-31 1-32 1-33 examination [graduated from an interior design educational program 1-34 recognized and approved by the board]; and 1-35

1-36 (2) has professional experience in the field of 1-37 interior design.

1-38 The board shall adopt rules establishing standards for: (c) 1-39 (1) the recognition and approval of interior design 1-40 educational programs; and

1-41 (2) the amounts and types of professional experience 1-42 necessary for registration examination eligibility.

1-43 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
