- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 521.011, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 521.011. SERVICES INFORMATION FOR VETERANS. The
- 8 department and the Texas Veterans Commission shall jointly develop
- 9 <u>a one-page informational paper about veterans services provided by</u>
- 10 this state for veterans who receive:
- 11 (1) a driver's license with a designation under
- 12 <u>Section 521.1235;</u> or
- 13 (2) a personal identification certificate with a
- 14 [veteran's] designation under Section 521.102 [a one-page
- 15 informational paper about veterans services provided by this
- 16 state].
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 521.101(1), Transportation Code, is
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- 19 (1) The application for the personal identification
- 20 certificate must provide space for the applicant:
- 21 (1) to voluntarily list any <u>information</u> [military
- 22 service] that may qualify the applicant to receive a personal
- 23 identification certificate with a [veteran's] designation under
- 24 Section 521.102; and

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(2) to include proof required by the department to 1 2 determine the applicant's eligibility to receive that designation. SECTION 3. Section 521.102, Transportation Code, is amended 3 by amending Subsections (a) and (c) and adding Subsections (b-1) 4 5 and (d) to read as follows: 6 (a) In this section: [7] 7 (1) "Disability rating" has the meaning assigned by 8 Section 11.22, Tax Code. 9 (2) "Disabled veteran" and "veteran" have the meanings assigned by Section 521.1235 [means a person who: 10 (1) has served in: 11 12 [(A) the army, navy, air force, coast guard, or marine corps of the United States; or 13 [(B) the Texas National Guard as defined 14 15 Section 431.001, Government Code; and 16 [(2) has been honorably discharged from the branch of 17 the service in which the person served]. (b-1) If a disabled veteran provides proof sufficient to the 18 department, the department, on request of the disabled veteran, 19 shall include on a personal identification certificate issued to 20 the disabled veteran in any available space on the face of the 21 personal identification certificate or on the reverse side of the 22 23 personal identification certificate: 24 (1) a disabled veteran designation; 25 (2) the disabled veteran's service-connected

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The department shall provide to the recipient of a
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   personal identification certificate with a [veteran's] designation

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          (d) Notwithstanding any other law, for purposes of

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   this state, a disabled veteran may use a personal identification
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   certificate described by Subsection (b-1) as satisfactory proof of
   the disabled veteran's disability rating, branch of service, and
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   honorable discharge.

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    (b-1) and (d) to read as follows:
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          (a) In this section:
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               (1) "Disability rating" has the meaning assigned by
   Section 11.22, Tax Code.
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               (2) "Disabled veteran" means a veteran who has
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   suffered a service-connected disability with a disability rating
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   of:
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                    (A) at least 50 percent; or
                    (B) 40 percent if the rating is due to the
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   amputation of a lower extremity.
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               (3) "Veteran" [ reteran"] means a person who:
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                    (A) \left[\frac{1}{1}\right] has served in:
                         (i) [\frac{A}{A}] the army, navy, air force, coast
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   guard, or marine corps of the United States; or
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veteran served.

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- 1 (ii) [(B)] the Texas National Guard as
- 2 defined by Section 437.001, Government Code; and
- 3 (B) $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$ has been honorably discharged from the
- 4 branch of the service in which the person served.
- 5 (b-1) If a disabled veteran provides proof sufficient to the
- 6 department, the department, on request of the disabled veteran,
- 7 shall include on a driver's license issued to the disabled veteran
- 8 in any available space on the face of the driver's license or on the
- 9 reverse side of the driver's license:
- 10 <u>(1) a disabled veteran designation;</u>
- 11 (2) the disabled veteran's service-connected
- 12 disability rating; and
- 13 (3) the branch of the service in which the disabled
- 14 veteran served.
- 15 (c) The department shall provide to the recipient of a
- 16 driver's license with a [veteran's] designation under this section
- 17 the informational paper described by Section 521.011 at the time
- 18 the license is issued.
- 19 (d) Notwithstanding any other law, for purposes of
- 20 obtaining a service or benefit available for disabled veterans in
- 21 this state, a disabled veteran may use a driver's license described
- 22 by Subsection (b-1) as satisfactory proof of the disabled veteran's
- 23 disability rating, branch of service, and honorable discharge.
- SECTION 5. Section 521.142(i), Transportation Code, is
- 25 amended to read as follows:
- 26 (i) The application must provide space for the applicant:
- 27 (1) to voluntarily list any information [military

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- 1 service] that may qualify the applicant to receive a license with a
- 2 [veteran's] designation under Section 521.1235; and
- 3 (2) to include proof required by the department to
- 4 determine the applicant's eligibility to receive that designation.
- 5 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
