## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the residency requirements for hunting and fishing 3 licenses. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 42.001, Parks and Wildlife Code, is 5 amended by amending Subdivision (1) and adding Subdivision (9) to 6 read as follows: 7 (1) "Resident" means: 8 9 (A) an individual who has resided continuously in this state for more than six months immediately before applying for 10 11 a hunting license; 12 (B) a member of the United States armed forces on 13 active duty; 14 (C) a dependent of a member of the United States armed forces on active duty; 15 if approved by the director, a terminally ill 16 (D) individual who is participating in an event sponsored by a 17 charitable nonprofit organization; 18 19 (E) a seasonal resident; or 20 (F) [<del>(E)</del>] a member of any other category of 21 individuals that the commission by regulation designates as 22 residents. 23 (9) "Seasonal resident" means an individual who 24 resides in this state for not less than 90 days in a calendar year.

States armed forces on active duty; 1 2 (D) a seasonal resident; or (E) [(4)] a member of any other category of 3 4 individuals that the commission by regulation designates as 5 residents. 6 (2) "Seasonal resident" means an individual who 7 resides in this state for not less than 90 days in a calendar year. SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2017. 12
