S.B. No. 1991

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the administration of federal funds under the
- 3 Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 2306.111(c), (c-1), and (c-2),
- 6 Government Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) In administering federal housing funds provided to the
- 8 state under the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act
- 9 (42 U.S.C. Section 12701 et seq.), the department shall $\underline{\text{allocate}}$
- 10 [expend]:
- 11 (1) 95 percent of these funds for the benefit of
- 12 non-participating small cities and rural areas that do not qualify
- 13 to receive funds under the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable
- 14 Housing Act directly from the United States Department of Housing
- 15 and Urban Development, except that an amount not to exceed 15
- 16 percent of the funds allocated under this subdivision may be
- 17 allocated to participating jurisdictions as necessary to meet the
- 18 requirements of federal law; and
- 19 (2) at least five percent of these funds for the
- 20 benefit of persons with disabilities who live in any area of this
- 21 state.
- 22 (c-1) Eligibility to apply for community housing
- 23 development organization set-aside funds under Subsection (c) is
- 24 determined by federal law [The following entities are eligible to

- 1 apply for set-aside funds under Subsection (c):
- 2 [(1) nonprofit providers of affordable housing,
- 3 including community housing development organizations; and
- 4 [(2) for-profit providers of affordable housing].
- 5 (c-2) In allocating set-aside funds under Subsection (c),
- 6 the department:
- 7 <u>(1)</u> may not give preference to nonprofit providers of
- 8 affordable housing, except as necessary to meet the requirements of
- 9 [required by] federal law; and
- 10 (2) shall allocate funds in accordance with any
- 11 applicable spending plan required under federal law.
- 12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act in amending
- 13 Section 2306.111, Government Code, applies only to an application
- 14 for financial assistance that is submitted to the Texas Department
- 15 of Housing and Community Affairs on or after January 1, 2018. An
- 16 application for financial assistance that is submitted to the
- 17 department before January 1, 2018, is governed by the law in effect
- 18 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former
- 19 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
