3 championship, the Breeders' Cup World Championships, a Formula One

- 6 National Cutting Horse Association Triple Crown, a national

- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
