3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 161, Health and Safety
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 161.01095 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 161.01095. HUMAN PAPILLOMAVIRUS ANNUAL REPORT. (a)
7	The department shall submit a report on the immunization rates for
8	human papillomavirus in this state to the governor, lieutenant
9	governor, and speaker of the house of representatives not later
10	than January 31 of each year. The department shall publish the
11	report on the department's Internet website.
12	(b) The report at a minimum must provide statistical
13	information on human papillomavirus immunizations for each county
14	in this state and this state for the preceding year, including:
15	(1) the number of persons immunized for humar
16	papillomavirus and the percentage of persons immunized for humar
17	papillomavirus compared to the number of persons eligible for that
18	<pre>immunization;</pre>
19	(2) the number of human papillomavirus vaccine doses
20	administered in total and in each dose interval;
21	(3) the number of persons immunized for humar
22	papillomavirus by age;
23	(4) the number of persons immunized for humar
24	papillomavirus by gender; and

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- 1 (5) a comparison between the number of human
- 2 papillomavirus vaccines administered and the number of other
- 3 recommended adolescent vaccines administered, including the
- 4 tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis, and meningococcal vaccines.
- 5 (c) In creating the report, the department shall use data
- 6 from the vaccines for children program established by the
- 7 department as authorized by 42 U.S.C. Section 1396s or the
- 8 <u>immunization registry established under Section 161.007.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
