1-19 relating to the distribution of the consolidated court cost.
 1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-21 SECTION 1. Section 133.102(e), Local Government Code, is
 1-22 amended to read as follows:

1-23 (e) The comptroller shall allocate the court costs received
 1-24 under this section to the following accounts and funds so that each
 1-25 receives to the extent practicable, utilizing historical data as
 1-26 applicable, the same amount of money the account or fund would have
 1-27 received if the court costs for the accounts and funds had been
 1-28 collected and reported separately, except that the account or fund
 1-29 may not receive less than the following percentages:

1-57 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-58 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

 1-61 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
