## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a requirement that a student's postsecondary transcript
3	include the average or median grade awarded in each class.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 51.979 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 51.979. TRANSPARENCY IN STUDENT TRANSCRIPTS. (a) In
8	this section, "general academic teaching institution" and "public
9	junior college" have the meanings assigned by Section 61.003.
10	(b) Each general academic teaching institution and each
11	<pre>public junior college shall include on a student's transcript, for</pre>
12	each class attempted by the student, the average grade that was
13	awarded to all students in the class. For a class for which letter
14	grades are awarded, the institution or college shall include on the
15	transcript the median grade of the letter grades awarded in the
16	class. The institution or college shall place the average or median
17	grade, as applicable, immediately to the right of the student's
18	individual grade.
19	(c) Subsection (b) does not apply to a class:
20	(1) offered to students solely on a pass-fail basis or
21	for independent study credit; or
22	(2) in which grades are reported for 10 students or
23	<u>fewer.</u>
24	(d) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall

- 1 adopt rules to administer this section.
- 2 SECTION 2. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board
- 3 shall adopt the rules required by Section 51.979, Education Code,
- 4 as added by this Act, not later than September 1, 2020.
- 5 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies
- 6 beginning with classes offered in the 2022 fall semester.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
