- 6 SECTION 1. Section 29.012, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(c-1)</u> The commissioner by rule shall require each school
- 9 district and open-enrollment charter school to include in the
- 10 district's or school's Public Education Information Management
- 11 System (PEIMS) report the number of children with disabilities
- 12 residing in a residential facility who:
- (1) are required to be tracked by the Residential
- 14 Facility Monitoring (RFM) System; and
- 15 (2) receive educational services from the district or
- 16 school.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
- 18 school year.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect only if a specific
- 20 appropriation for the implementation of the Act is provided in a
- 21 general appropriations act of the 85th Legislature.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
