1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to a requirement that school districts and open-enrollment
 1-23 charter schools report certain information regarding children with
 1-24 disabilities who reside in residential facilities.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Section 29.012, Education Code, is amended by
 1-27 adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:

1-28 (c-1) The commissioner by rule shall require each school
 1-29 district and open-enrollment charter school to include in the
 1-30 district's or school's Public Education Information Management
 1-31 System (PEIMS) report the number of children with disabilities
 1-32 residing in a residential facility who:

1-33 (1) are required to be tracked by the Residential
 1-34 Facility Monitoring (RFM) System; and
 1-35 (2) receive educational services from the district or
 1-36 school.

1-37 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
 1-38 school year.

1-39 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect only if a specific
 1-40 appropriation for the implementation of the Act is provided in a
 1-41 general appropriations act of the 85th Legislature.

1-42 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-43 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-44 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-45 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-46 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
