1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to calculation of average daily attendance for public
 1-23 school students in blended learning programs.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 42.005, Education Code, is amended by
 1-26 adding Subsection (g-1) to read as follows:

1-27 (g-1) The commissioner shall adopt rules to calculate
 1-28 average daily attendance for students participating in a blended
 1-29 learning program in which classroom instruction is supplemented
 1-30 with applied workforce learning opportunities, including
 1-31 participation of students in internships, externships, and
 1-32 apprenticeships.

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
 1-34 school year.

1-35 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-36 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-37 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-39 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
