- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 4, Government Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Chapter 424 to read as follows:

7 CHAPTER 424. IMMIGRATION

- 8 Sec. 424.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "training
- 9 program" means a training program operated by United States
- 10 Immigration and Customs Enforcement for training local law
- 11 enforcement officers to enforce federal immigration law. The term
- 12 includes the immigration authority delegation program and the
- 13 immigration authority delegation refresher training program
- 14 <u>established under Section 287(g) of the federal Immigration and</u>
- 15 Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. Section 1357(g)).
- 16 Sec. 424.002. IMMIGRATION DELEGATION TRAINING GRANT
- 17 PROGRAM FOR LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT. (a) The office of the governor
- 18 shall develop and maintain a grant program that awards grants for
- 19 the expenses incurred by a local law enforcement agency related to
- 20 the attendance of a law enforcement officer of the agency in a
- 21 training program.
- (b) A local law enforcement agency may apply to the office
- 23 of the governor in the form and manner required by the office of the
- 24 governor for a grant under the grant program established by this

- 1 section. To qualify for a grant, an applicant must:
- 2 (1) apply for preauthorization from the office of the
- 3 governor before the law enforcement officer attends the training
- 4 program; and
- 5 (2) demonstrate that the law enforcement officer who
- 6 will attend the training program:
- 7 (A) is primarily engaged in making arrests; and
- 8 (B) meets all of the United States Immigration
- 9 and Customs Enforcement officer selection requirements required to
- 10 attend the training program.
- 11 Sec. 424.003. GRANT AMOUNT. If the application for a grant
- 12 under the grant program established under this section is approved,
- 13 the office of the governor shall issue a grant to the applicant in
- 14 the amount of:
- 15 (1) the salary of the law enforcement officer for:
- 16 (A) four weeks, if the officer attends the basic
- 17 training course under the training program; or
- 18 (B) one week, if the officer attends the
- 19 refresher course under the training program;
- 20 (2) the costs incurred by the applicant because of the
- 21 officer's absence while the officer is attending the training
- 22 program, including overtime pay to another officer to fulfill the
- 23 duties of the absent officer; and
- 24 (3) other expenses the office of the governor
- 25 considers necessary for the participation in the training program.
- 26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect only if a specific
- 27 appropriation for the implementation of the Act is provided in a

- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
