## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2	relating to the inspection, maintenance, and repair of guardrails
3	by the Texas Department of Transportation.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 201, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 201.623 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 201.623. GUARDRAIL INSPECTION, MAINTENANCE, AND
8	REPAIR. (a) This section applies only to a guardrail constructed or
9	a highway or right-of-way of a highway that is in the state highway
10	system.
11	(b) The department shall conduct a study regarding the
12	inspection, maintenance, and repair of guardrails. The study must
13	<pre>include:</pre>
14	(1) the number of guardrails;
15	(2) the date of the last inspection of each guardrail;
16	(3) the condition of each guardrail;
17	(4) standards and best practices for the inspection,
18	maintenance, and repair of guardrails;
19	(5) the potential of each guardrail to be damaged by a
20	<pre>motor vehicle;</pre>
21	(6) whether each guardrail is designed to absorb the
22	energy from a potential impact from a motor vehicle; and
23	(7) an estimate of the amount of money and the number
24	of full-time equivalent employees necessary to inspect and maintair

- 2 (c) The department shall develop a plan to implement the
- 3 study conducted under Subsection (b). The plan must:
- 4 (1) dedicate a portion of money from funds related to
- 5 highway maintenance for the inspection, maintenance, and repair of
- 6 guardrails;
- 7 (2) establish minimum standards based on the results
- 8 of the study under which the department conducts inspection,
- 9 maintenance, and repair of guardrails; and
- 10 (3) establish a schedule for the inspection,
- 11 maintenance, and repair of guardrails.
- 12 (d) The department shall:
- 13 (1) update the plan developed under Subsection (c) as
- 14 new information is made available regarding the inspection,
- 15 maintenance, and repair of guardrails;
- 16 (2) maintain records of the inspection, maintenance,
- 17 and repair of guardrails; and
- 18 (3) publish on the department's Internet website the
- 19 records maintained by the department under Subdivision (2).
- 20 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2019, the Texas
- 21 Department of Transportation shall submit to the governor, the
- 22 lieutenant governor, and the legislature a report on the results of
- 23 the study conducted under Section 201.623(b), Transportation Code,
- 24 as added by this Act.
- 25 SECTION 3. Not later than January 1, 2021, the Texas
- 26 Department of Transportation shall submit to the governor, the
- 27 lieutenant governor, and the legislature the plan required by

- 1 Section 201.623(c), Transportation Code, as added by this Act.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
