

AN ACT

relating to the requirement that the Texas Workforce Commission provide certain employment information for secondary school students.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 302.014(a), Labor Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) The commission shall provide the Texas Education Agency with information at least each quarter, disaggregated by county or other appropriate region, regarding:

(1) current and projected employment opportunities in this state;

(2) career and technical education partnership opportunities with business and industry; and

(3) professional development opportunities for teachers and learning opportunities for students through industry mentorships, internships, summer programs, after-school programs, and career-based student leadership opportunities~~[, disaggregated by county or other appropriate region]~~.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
