S.B. No. 2105

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the requirement that the Texas Workforce Commission
3 provide certain employment information for secondary school
4 students.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 302.014(a), Labor Code, is amended to
7 read as follows:

8 (a) The commission shall provide the Texas Education Agency
9 with information at least each quarter, disaggregated by county or
10 other appropriate region, regarding:

11 (1) current and projected employment opportunities in
12 this state;

13 (2) career and technical education partnership
14 opportunities with business and industry; and

15 (3) professional development opportunities for
16 teachers and learning opportunities for students through industry
17 mentorships, internships, summer programs, after-school programs,
18 and career-based student leadership opportunities~~[, disaggregated~~
19 ~~by county or other appropriate region].~~

20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
