A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to requiring the Texas Education Agency to conduct a study
- 3 regarding school district consolidation in Cameron County.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "agency" means the
- 6 Texas Education Agency.

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- 7 SECTION 2. STUDY REGARDING SCHOOL DISTRICT CONSOLIDATION.
- 8 The agency shall conduct a study regarding school district
- 9 consolidation in Cameron County. In conducting the study, the
- 10 agency shall consider:
- 11 (1) any cost savings associated with economies of
- 12 scale achieved through school district consolidation; and
- 13 (2) any impact of school district consolidation on
- 14 entitlements under the Foundation School Program.
- 15 SECTION 3. REPORT TO LEGISLATURE. Not later than December
- 16 1, 2018, the agency shall submit a report that includes the results
- 17 of the study and any associated recommendations to:
- 18 (1) the governor;
- 19 (2) the lieutenant governor;
- 20 (3) the speaker of the house of representatives;
- 21 (4) the presiding officer of each legislative standing
- 22 committee with primary jurisdiction over primary and secondary
- 23 education; and
- 24 (5) the members of the house of representatives and

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- 1 the senate whose district includes any part of Cameron County.
- 2 SECTION 4. EXPIRATION. This Act expires September 1, 2019.
- 3 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 4 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 5 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 6 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 7 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
