- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 162.005(f), Family Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (f) The department, licensed child-placing agency, [parent,
- 9 guardian, person, or entity who prepares and files the original
- 10 report and the parent or guardian, regardless of whether the parent
- 11 or guardian prepares and files the original report, are [is]
- 12 required to furnish supplemental medical, psychological, and
- 13 psychiatric information to the adoptive parents if that information
- 14 becomes available and to file the supplemental information where
- 15 the original report is filed. The supplemental information shall
- 16 be retained for as long as the original report is required to be
- 17 retained.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
