- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Sec. 42.151, Education Code is amended by adding
- 7 the following:
- 8 (f-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (f), a student who is 18
- 9 years of age or older who has met graduation credit requirements and
- 10 <u>is in an off home campus instructional arrangement is a full-time</u>
- 11 equivalent student if the student receives 20 hours of contact a
- 12 week. A student described by this subsection is a part-time
- 13 equivalent student if the student receives 10 hours or more but less
- 14 than 20 hours of contact a week.
- 15 (1) The commissioner may adopt rules necessary to
- 16 administer this section.
- 17 SECTION 2. The commissioner may adopt rules to administer
- 18 this section.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act applied beginning with the 2017-2018
- 20 school year.
