- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 204.2045, Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows: 6
- VOLUNTEER CARE AND SERVICES PERFORMED DURING 7 Sec. 204.2045.
- DISASTER. (a) The supervision and delegation requirements of this 8
- 9 chapter and Subtitle B do not apply to medical tasks performed by a
- physician assistant: 10

- 11 (1) during a disaster under the state emergency
- 12 management plan adopted under Section 418.042, Government Code;
- 13 (2) during $[\frac{1}{1000}]$ a disaster declared by the governor
- or United States government; or 14
- (3) as a volunteer for a charitable organization or at 15
- a public or private event, including a religious event, sporting 16
- event, community event, or health fair. 17
- (a-1) This section does not apply to medical tasks performed 18
- by a physician assistant for compensation or other remuneration. 19
- 20 (b) A physician assistant performing medical tasks under
- 21 this section:
- 22 (1) is entitled to the immunity from liability
- 23 provided by Section 74.151, Civil Practice and Remedies Code; and
- 24 (2) is acting within the scope of the physician

- 1 assistant's license for purposes of immunity under Section
- 2 <u>84.004(c), Civil Practice and Remedies</u> Code.
- 3 (c) A physician assistant may perform tasks described by
- 4 this section:
- 5 (1) under the supervision of any physician who is also
- 6 performing volunteer work in the disaster, for the charitable
- 7 organization, or at the public or private event; or
- 8 (2) without the supervision of a physician, if a
- 9 physician is not available to provide supervision.
- 10 (d) A physician assistant employed by the United States
- 11 government or licensed in another state may perform medical tasks
- 12 in this state in circumstances described by Subsection (a) without
- 13 holding a license in this state.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 204.2045, Occupations Code, as amended
- 15 by this Act, applies only to services performed on or after the
- 16 effective date of this Act. Services performed before that date are
- 17 governed by the law in effect on the date the services were
- 18 performed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 19 purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
