15	(5) "District" means the Lakewood Improvement						
16	District of Harris County.						
17	Sec. 3951.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a						
18	special district created under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas						
19	Constitution.						
20	Sec. 3951.003. PURPOSE; DECLARATION OF INTENT. (a) The						
21	creation of the district is essential to accomplish the purposes of						
22	Sections 52 and 52-a, Article III, and Section 59, Article XVI,						
23	Texas Constitution, and other public purposes stated in this						
24	chapter. By creating the district and in authorizing the city, the						

county, and other political subdivisions to contract with the 1 2 district, the legislature has established a program to accomplish 3 the public purposes set out in Section 52-a, Article III, Texas 4 Constitution. 5 (b) The creation of the district is necessary to promote, develop, encourage, and maintain employment, commerce, 6 transportation, housing, tourism, recreation, the 7 arts, 8 entertainment, economic development, safety, and the public 9 welfare in the district, and to accomplish the redevelopment of land in the district. 10 11 (c) This chapter and the creation of the district may not be 12 interpreted to relieve the city or the county from providing the 13 level of services provided as of the effective date of the Act enacting this chapter to the area in the district. The district is 14 created to supplement and not to supplant city or county services 15 provided in the district. 16 Sec. 3951.004. FINDINGS OF BENEFIT AND PUBLIC PURPOSE. 17 (a) The district is created to serve a public use and benefit. 18 (b) All land and other property included in the district 19 20 will benefit from the improvements and services to be provided by the district under powers conferred by Sections 52 and 52-a, 21 Article III, and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and 22 other powers granted under this chapter. 23 24 (c) The creation of the district is in the public interest 25 and is essential to further the public purposes of: 26 (1) developing and diversifying the economy of the 27 state;

1	(2) eliminating unemployment and underemployment; and							
2	(3) developing or expanding transportation and							
3	commerce.							
4	(d) The district will:							
5	(1) promote the health, safety, and general welfare of							
6	residents, employers, potential employees, employees, visitors,							
7	and consumers in the district, and of the public;							
8	(2) provide needed funding for the district to							
9	preserve, maintain, and enhance the economic health and vitality of							
10	the district territory as a community and business center;							
11	(3) promote the health, safety, welfare, and enjoyment							
12	of the public by providing pedestrian ways, parking facilities, and							
13	conduit facilities and by landscaping and developing certain areas							
14	in the district, which are necessary for the restoration,							
15	preservation, and enhancement of scenic beauty; and							
16	(4) provide for road, bridge, and recreational							
17	facilities for the district.							
18	(e) Pedestrian ways along or across a street, whether at							
19	grade or above or below the surface, and street lighting, street							
20	landscaping, parking, and street art objects are parts of and							
21	necessary components of a street or road and are considered to be a							
22	street or road improvement.							
23	(f) The district will not act as the agent or							
24	instrumentality of any private interest even though the district							
25	will benefit many private interests as well as the public.							
26	Sec. 3951.005. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The							
27	district is initially composed of the territory described by							

S.B. No. 2276 Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter. 1 2 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of 3 the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake in the 4 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process does not affect the district's: 5 (1) organization, existence, or validity; 6 7 (2) right to issue any type of bonds for the purposes for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and 8 9 interest on bonds; (3) right to impose or collect an assessment or tax; or 10 11 (4) legality or operation. Sec. 3951.006. ELIGIBILITY FOR INCLUSION IN SPECIAL ZONES. 12 13 All or any part of the area of the district is eligible to be 14 included in: 15 (1) a tax increment reinvestment zone created under 16 Chapter 311, Tax Code; 17 (2) a tax abatement reinvestment zone created under Chapter 312, Tax Code; 18 (3) an enterprise zone created under Chapter 2303, 19 Government Code; or 20 21 (4) an industrial district created under Chapter 42, Local Government Code. 22 Sec. 3951.007. APPLICABILITY OF MUNICIPAL MANAGEMENT 23 DISTRICTS LAW. Except as otherwise provided by this chapter, 24 25 Chapter 375, Local Government Code, applies to the district. Sec. 3951.008. CONSTRUCTION OF CHAPTER. This chapter shall 26 27 be liberally construed in conformity with the findings and purposes

24	(3) a nonvoting director.							
25	Sec. 3951.055. COMPENSATION. A director is entitled to							
26	receive fees of office and reimbursement for actual expenses as							
27	provided by Section 49.060, Water Code. Sections 375.069 and

20	Sec. 3951.102. IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND SERVICES. The					
21	district may provide, design, construct, acquire, improve,					
22	relocate, operate, maintain, or finance an improvement project or					
23	service using any money available to the district, or contract with					
24	a governmental or private entity to provide, design, construct,					
25	acquire, improve, relocate, operate, maintain, or finance an					
26	improvement project or service authorized under this chapter or					
27	Chapter 375, Local Government Code.					

1	Sec. 3951.103. DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION POWERS. The
2	district, using money available to the district, may exercise the
3	powers given to a development corporation under Chapter 505, Local

7	district may join and pay dues to a charitable or nonprofit

10	Sec. 3951.108. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT. (a) The district may						
11	engage in activities that accomplish the economic development						
12	purposes of the district.						
13	(b) The district may establish and provide for the						
14	administration of one or more programs to promote state or local						
15	economic development and to stimulate business and commercial						
16	activity in the district, including programs to:						
17	(1) make loans and grants of public money; and						
18	(2) provide district personnel and services.						
19	(c) The district may create economic development programs						
20	and exercise the economic development powers provided to						
21	municipalities by:

24	Sec. 3951.109. PARKING FACILITIES. (a) The district may						
25	acquire, lease as lessor or lessee, construct, develop, own,

1	structures or accommodations for parking motor vehicles off the
2	streets and related appurtenances.
3	(b) The district's parking facilities serve the public
4	purposes of the district and are owned, used, and held for a public
5	purpose even if leased or operated by a private entity for a term of
6	years.
7	(c) The district's parking facilities are parts of and
8	necessary components of a street and are considered to be a street
9	or road improvement.
10	(d) The development and operation of the district's parking
11	facilities may be considered an economic development program.
12	Sec. 3951.110. ANNEXATION AND EXCLUSION OF LAND. (a) The
13	district may annex land as provided by Subchapter J, Chapter 49,
14	Water Code.
15	(b) The district may exclude land as provided by Subchapter
16	J, Chapter 49, Water Code. Section 375.044(b), Local Government
17	Code, does not apply to the district.
18	Sec. 3951.111. NAVIGATION DISTRICT POWERS. (a) The
19	district has the powers provided by the general law of this state
20	applicable to navigation districts created under Section 59,
21	Article XVI, Texas Constitution, including Chapters 60 and 62,
22	Water Code.
23	(b) The district may purchase, construct, acquire, own,
24	operate, maintain, improve, or extend, inside and outside the
25	district, a canal, waterway, bulkhead, dock, or other improvement

27	purposes of the district.

1	Sec. 3951.112. ROAD DISTRICT POWERS. The district has the						
2	powers provided by the general laws relating to road districts and						
3	road utility districts created under Section 52(b), Article III,						
4	Texas Constitution, including Chapters 257 and 441, Transportation						
5	Code.						
6	Sec. 3951.113. ROAD STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS. (a) A						
7	road project must meet all applicable construction standards,						
8	zoning and subdivision requirements, and regulations of each						
9	municipality in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial						
10	jurisdiction the road project is located.						
11	(b) If a road project is not located in the corporate limits						
12	or extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, the road						
13	project must meet all applicable construction standards,						
14	subdivision requirements, and regulations of each county in which						
15	the road project is located.						
16	(c) If the state will maintain and operate the road, the						
17	Texas Transportation Commission must approve the plans and						
18	specifications of the road project.						
19	Sec. 3951.114. PROPERTY OF CERTAIN UTILITIES EXEMPT FROM						
20	ASSESSMENTS AND FEES. The district may not impose an assessment,						
21	impact fee, or standby fee on the property, including the						
22	equipment, rights-of-way, easements, facilities, or improvements,						
23	<u>of:</u>						
24	(1) an electric utility or a power generation company						
25	as defined by Section 31.002, Utilities Code;						
26	(2) a gas utility, as defined by Section 101.003 or						
27	121.001, Utilities Code, or a person who owns pipelines used for the						

1 transportation or sale of oil or gas or a product or constituent of 2 oil or gas; (3) a person who owns pipelines used for 3 the 4 transportation or sale of carbon dioxide; 5 (4) a telecommunications provider as defined by Section 51.002, Utilities Code; or 6 (5) a cable service provider or video service provider 7 as defined by Section 66.002, Utilities Code. 8 Sec. 3951.115. USE OF ELECTRICAL OR OPTICAL LINES. 9 (a) The district may impose an assessment to pay the cost of: 10 11 (1) burying or removing electrical power lines, telephone lines, cable or fiber-optic lines, or any other type of 12 13 electrical or optical line; and 14 (2) removing poles and any elevated lines using the 15 poles. 16 (b) The district may finance, acquire, construct, improve, operate, maintain, or charge fees for the use of the district 17 18 conduits for another person's: (1) telecommunications network; or 19 20 (2) fiber-optic cable. (c) Consistent with Title 2, Utilities Code, the district 21 may finance, construct, or maintain conduits for: 22 (1) electronic transmission and distribution lines 23 and supporting facilities; or 24 25 (2) other types of transmission and distribution lines and supporting facilities. 26 27 (d) The district may not require a person to use a district

Sec. 3951.155. TAX AND ASSESSMENT ABATEMENTS. The district 21 may designate reinvestment zones and may grant abatements of a tax 22 23 or assessment on property in the zones. Sec. 3951.156. RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY NOT EXEMPT. Section 24 25 375.161, Local Government Code, does not apply to the district. Sec. 3951.157. COMPETITIVE BIDDING. (b) A contract approved by the district voters may contain a 10

11 provision stating that the contract may be modified or amended by
12 the board without further voter approval.

Sec. 3951.204. AUTHORITY TO BORROW MONEY AND TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS. (a) The district may borrow money on terms determined by the board. Section 375.205, Local Government Code, does not apply to a loan, line of credit, or other borrowing from a bank or financial institution secured by revenue other than ad valorem taxes.

19 (b) The district may issue bonds, notes, or other 20 obligations payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, 21 assessments, impact fees, revenue, contract payments, grants, or 22 other district money, or any combination of those sources of money, 23 to pay for any authorized district purpose.

(c) The limitation on the outstanding principal amount of
 bonds, notes, and other obligations provided by Section 49.4645,
 Water Code, does not apply to the district.

27 Sec. 3951.205. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district

1 issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the 2 board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing 3 direct annual ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, for each year that all or part of the bonds are outstanding as 4 5 required and in the manner provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602, 6 Water Code. 7 Sec. 3951.206. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of 8 issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad 9 valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the 10 11 real property in the district. 12 SUBCHAPTER F. SALES AND USE TAX 13 Sec. 3951.251. MEANINGS OF WORDS AND PHRASES. A word or phrase used in this subchapter that is defined by Chapter 151 or 14 321, Tax Code, has the meaning assigned by Chapter 151 or 321, Tax 15 Code. 16 Sec. 3951.252. APPLICABILITY OF CERTAIN TAX 17 CODE PROVISIONS. (a) The provisions of Subchapters C, D, E, and F, 18 Chapter 323, Tax Code, relating to county sales and use taxes apply 19 20 to the application, collection, and administration of a sales and use tax imposed under this subchapter to the extent consistent with 21 this chapter, as if references in Chapter 323, Tax Code, to a county 22 23 referred to the district and references to a commissioners court referred to the board. 24 25 (b) Sections 323.401-323.404 and 323.505, Tax Code, do not 26 apply to a tax imposed under this subchapter. 27 Sec. 3951.253. AUTHORIZATION; ELECTION. (a) The district

shall adopt, reduce, or repeal the sales and use tax authorized by 1 2 this subchapter at an election in which a majority of the voters of 3 the district voting in the election approve the adoption, 4 reduction, or repeal of the tax, as applicable. 5 (b) The board by order shall call an election to adopt, reduce, or repeal a sales and use tax. The election shall be held on 6 7 the first authorized uniform election date that occurs after the time required by Section 3.005, Election Code. 8 9 (c) The district shall provide notice of the election and shall hold the election in the manner prescribed by Chapter 54, 10 11 Water Code, for bond elections for municipal utility districts. 12 (d) The ballots shall be printed to provide for voting for 13 or against the following appropriate proposition: (1) "Adoption of a ____ percent district sales and use 14 15 tax in the district"; 16 (2) "Reduction of the district sales and use tax in the 17 district from ____ percent to ____ percent"; or 18 (3) "Repeal of the district sales and use tax in the district." 19 20 Sec. 3951.254. EFFECTIVE DATE OF TAX. A tax imposed under this subchapter or the repeal or reduction of a tax under this 21 subchapter takes effect on the first day of the first calendar 22 23 quarter that occurs after the date the comptroller receives the 24 copy of the resolution as required by Section 323.405(b), Tax Code. 25 Sec. 3951.255. SALES AND USE TAX RATE. (a) On adoption of the tax authorized by this subchapter, there is imposed a tax of two 26 27 percent, or the maximum rate at which the combined tax rate of all

1 local sales and use taxes in any location in the district does not 2 exceed two percent, on the receipts from the sale at retail of 3 taxable items in the district, and an excise tax on the use, 4 storage, or other consumption in the district of taxable items 5 purchased, leased, or rented from a retailer during the period that 6 the tax is in effect. 7 (b) The rate of the excise tax is the same as the rate of the 8 sales tax portion of the tax and is applied to the sales price of the 9 taxable item. Sec. 3951.256. EXAMINATION AND RECEIPT OF INFORMATION. 10 The 11 district may examine and receive information related to the imposition of a sales and use tax to the same extent as if the 12 13 district were a municipality. Sec. 3951.257. ALTERNATIVE METHOD 14 OF IMPOSITION. Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter, the 15 district may impose the sales and use tax as provided by Subchapter 16 F, Chapter 383, Local Government Code, instead of as provided by the 17 other provisions of this subchapter. 18 SUBCHAPTER G. DEFINED AREAS 19 20 Sec. 3951.301. AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH DEFINED AREAS OR 21 DESIGNATED PROPERTY. The district may define areas or designate certain property of the district to pay for improvements, 22 facilities, or services that primarily benefit that area or 23 property and do not generally and directly benefit the district as a 24 25 whole. 26 Sec. 3951.302. PROCEDURE FOR ELECTION. (a) Before the 27 district may impose an ad valorem tax or issue bonds payable from ad

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valorem taxes of the defined area or designated property, the board 1 2 shall hold an election in the defined area or in the designated property only. 3 (b) The board may submit the issues to the voters on the same 4 5 ballot to be used in another election. 6 Sec. 3951.303. (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

(c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor,
 lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives

1 within the required time.

2 (d) The general law relating to consent by political 3 subdivisions to the creation of districts with conservation, 4 reclamation, and road powers and the inclusion of land in those 5 districts has been complied with.

6 (e) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this 7 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect 8 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act have been 9 fulfilled and accomplished.

10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
