1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the dissolution of the Angelina County Water Control
 1-20 and Improvement District No. 3 and the territory of the Angelina
 1-21 County Fresh Water Supply District No. 1.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. (a) Beginning on the effective date of this
 1-24 Act, the directors of the Angelina County Water Control and
 1-25 Improvement District No. 3 shall wind up the affairs of the
 1-26 district.

1-27 (b) On the 30th day after the effective date of this Act:

1-28 (1) the Angelina County Water Control and Improvement
 1-29 District No. 3 is dissolved;

1-30 (2) the terms of the directors of the district expire;
 1-31 and

1-32 (3) all assets and liabilities of the district are
 1-33 transferred to the Angelina County Fresh Water Supply District No.
 1-34 1.

1-35 SECTION 2. Subtitle B, Title 6, Special District Local Laws
 1-36 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 6918 to read as follows:

1-37 CHAPTER 6918. ANGELINA COUNTY FRESH WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT NO. 1;
 1-38 TERRITORY

1-39 Sec. 6918.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "district"
 1-40 means the Angelina County Fresh Water Supply District No. 1.

1-41 Sec. 6918.002. ADDITIONAL TERRITORY. On the effective date
 1-42 of the Act enacting this chapter, the territory of the former
 1-43 Angelina County Water Control and Improvement District No. 3, as
 1-44 that territory existed on April 1, 2017, is added to the territory
 1-45 of the district.

1-46 SECTION 3. Before the 30th day after the effective date of
 1-47 this Act, the board of directors of the Angelina County Water
 1-48 Control and Improvement District No. 3 may select from the members
 1-49 serving on the board on the date of the selection one member to
 1-50 serve as a nonvoting member of the board of the Angelina County
 1-51 Fresh Water Supply District No. 1 from the date of the selection
 1-52 until the next election of directors for the Angelina County Fresh
 1-53 Water Supply District No. 1.

1-54 SECTION 4. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
 1-55 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
 1-56 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
 1-57 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
 1-58 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
 1-59 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
 1-60 Government Code.

2-1 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
2-2 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
2-3 Environmental Quality.

2-4 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
2-5 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
2-6 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
2-7 representatives within the required time.

2-8 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
2-9 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
2-10 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
2-11 and accomplished.

2-12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2-13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
2-14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2-15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
2-16 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
