AN ACT

- 2 relating to the Fairfield Hospital District.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 1015.052, Special District Local Laws
- 5 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 1015.052. NOTICE OF ELECTION. Notice [At least 35 days
- 7 before the date of an election of directors, notice] of <u>an</u> [the]
- 8 election of directors shall be published in accordance with Chapter
- 9 4, Election Code [one time in a newspaper with general circulation
- 10 in the district].
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 1015.252, Special District Local Laws
- 12 Code, is amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection
- 13 (b-1) to read as follows:
- 14 (b) The tax rate for all purposes may not exceed 12 cents on
- 15 each \$100 valuation of all taxable property in the district, unless
- 16 the tax rate is increased as provided by Section 1015.254.
- 17 (b-1) If an increase in the tax rate is approved at an
- 18 election under Section 1015.254, the tax rate for all purposes may
- 19 not exceed the maximum tax rate approved by the voters at the
- 20 <u>election</u>.
- 21 SECTION 3. Subchapter F, Chapter 1015, Special District
- 22 Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Section 1015.254 to read as
- 23 follows:
- Sec. 1015.254. ELECTION TO INCREASE MAXIMUM TAX RATE. (a)

- 1 The board may order an election to increase the maximum tax rate of
- 2 the district to a rate not to exceed 25 cents on each \$100 valuation
- 3 of the taxable property in the district.
- 4 (b) Subject to Subsection (d), the board shall order an
- 5 election to increase the maximum tax rate of the district on
- 6 presentation of a petition that:
- 7 (1) requests the election;
- 8 (2) states the maximum tax rate to be voted on at the
- 9 election; and
- 10 (3) is signed by at least 100 registered voters of the
- 11 district, as determined by the most recent official list of
- 12 registered voters.
- 13 (c) The board by order shall set a time and place to hold a
- 14 hearing on the petition. The board shall set a date for the hearing
- 15 that is not earlier than the 11th day after the date the board
- 16 <u>issues the order.</u>
- 17 (d) If, after the hearing, the board determines that the
- 18 petition is in proper form and that an increase of the maximum tax
- 19 rate would benefit the district, the board shall order an election
- 20 to authorize the increase of the maximum tax rate to the tax rate
- 21 stated in the petition.
- (e) The election order must state:
- 23 <u>(1) the nature of the election, including the</u>
- 24 proposition that is to appear on the ballot;
- 25 (2) the maximum tax rate to be voted on at the
- 26 election;
- 27 (3) the date of the election;

- 1 (4) the hours during which the polls will be open; and
- 2 (5) the location of the polling places.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
