1-15 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1-16 WHEREAS, The Montgomery County Veterans Memorial Commission
1-17 is working to establish a new memorial park in Conroe in honor of
1-18 all veterans of the United States armed forces, especially those
1-19 from Montgomery County; and

1-20 WHEREAS, While the downtown area of Conroe already features a
1-21 veterans memorial park, the property is incapable of further
1-22 upgrades or expansion; the commission's desired site for the new
1-23 memorial is located on land owned by the City of Conroe and the
1-24 State of Texas, adjacent to the intersection of Interstate 45 and
1-25 State Highway 105, and the group has secured the cooperation of the
1-26 municipal and county governments for the installation; and

1-27 WHEREAS, Americans owe an immeasurable debt to the men and
1-28 women who have sacrificed so much in service to our nation, and
1-29 through its worthwhile efforts, the Montgomery County Veterans
1-30 Memorial Commission is helping to ensure that their bravery and
1-31 heroism are remembered for years to come; now, therefore, be it

1-32 RESOLVED, That the 85th Legislature of the State of Texas
1-33 hereby urge the Texas Department of Transportation, the Texas
1-34 Historical Commission, the Texas Veterans Commission, and all other
1-35 appropriate state agencies to offer full aid and support to the
1-36 Montgomery County Veterans Memorial Commission in its mission to
1-37 establish a new veterans memorial in Conroe; and, be it further

1-38 RESOLVED, That the Texas secretary of state forward official
1-39 copies of this resolution to the chairs of the commissions and the
1-40 executive directors of the Texas Department of Transportation, the
1-41 Texas Historical Commission, and the Texas Veterans Commission as
1-42 expressions of the sentiment of the Texas Legislature.
