- 1 WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 1839 has been adopted by the senate
- 2 and the house of representatives and is being prepared for

- 4 WHEREAS, The bill contains technical errors that should be
- 5 corrected; now, therefore, be it
- 6 RESOLVED by the 85th Legislature of the State of Texas, That
- 7 the enrolling clerk of the senate be instructed to make the
- 8 following corrections to the enrolled version of Senate Bill
- 9 No. 1839:
- 10 (1) In SECTION 3 of the bill, in the recital for amended
- 11 Section 21.044, Education Code (page 2, lines 8-9), between
- 12 "amended by" and "adding", insert "amending Subsection (c-1) and".
- 13 (2) In SECTION 3 of the bill, immediately following the
- 14 recital for amended Section 21.044, Education Code (page 2, between
- 15 lines 9 and 10), insert the following:
- 16 (c-1) The [Any] minimum academic qualifications for a
- 17 certificate specified under Subsection (a) [that require a person
- 18 to possess a bachelor's degree] must [also] require that the person
- 19 receive, as part of the training required to obtain that
- 20 certificate, instruction regarding mental health, substance abuse,
- 21 and youth suicide. The instruction required must:
- 22 (1) be provided through or acquired from a program
- 23 selected from the list of recommended best practice-based programs
- 24 established under Section 161.325, Health and Safety Code; [and]

- 1 (2) include effective strategies for teaching and
- 2 intervening with students with mental or emotional disorders,
- 3 including de-escalation techniques and positive behavioral
- 4 interventions and supports; and
- 5 (3) be implemented in compliance with requirements of
- 6 the program selected under Subdivision (1).
- 7 (3) In SECTION 12 of the bill, strike Subdivision (3),
- 8 repealing Section 21.057(e), Education Code, (page 10, line 9).
